- a. New Fire Station #16

Discussion:

Chief Fors provided presentation and spoke to the history and needs of fire station #16. He spoke to current challenges i.e., unable to accommodate equipment size, storage, training areas, personnel sleeping and workout area, operation workspace and lieutenants' quarters.

- Mr. Johnathan Tallman, Assistant Vice President of Dewberry Designers PC, discussed current plans for the new firehouse location and design.
- Ms. Colette Rozanski, Business Development Director, RC Wegman Construction Company, spoke to the project timeline.
- Mr. Doug Bohr, Estimator, RC Wegman Construction Company, spoke to the bid timeline, outlining a start timeline of mid-November and completed in January 2023, and noted that an average of 25 bid packages housing 5 to 10 bids per category is not uncommon.

Ms. Jane McNiven, of the Hanoverian Estates Homeowners Association and Ms. Rochelle, resident of Hanoverian Estates, spoke to their disappointment of the location of the firehouse which will be going into their neighborhood and noted that no one had let them know that it would be going through their neighborhood at any given time.
