Important Notice: Pesticide, Herbicide, and Insecticide Application Notification

Public Act 103-0976 regulates the use of pesticides, herbicides, and insecticides in municipalities. This Act requires municipalities and government entities to give the public 24 hours of notice before applying pesticides, herbicides, or insecticides on a public right-of-way within the municipality's corporate boundaries. Under Public Act 103-0976, the Village of Hanover Park is implementing enhanced notification procedures to keep our community informed about pesticide, herbicide, and insecticide applications.

The applications aim to treat and control insects and broadleaf weeds in Village areas, mitigating the potential risk of infestations to residents and right-of-ways. Treatment will target the affected areas specifically and may require multiple applications for complete eradication. The application will be conducted by the Village of Hanover Park Forestry Department or a licensed contractor authorized by the Village.

The Village does not maintain:

1. HOA properties
2. Roadways and shoulders of state and county-owned right-of-ways

Application Notifications

Application Schedule

1. Location: within the Village of Hanover Park boundaries
2. Season: April 1st – November 30th
3. Pesticide Time of Application: between dawn and dusk
4. Herbicide Time of Application: between dawn and dusk
5. Insecticide Time of Application: between dawn and dusk
6. Purpose: weed control and prevention, invasive species control

Emergency Exceptions

Please note that advance notice requirements may be waived in certain emergency situations, such as a potential disease threat to individuals or natural disaster recovery efforts.

Product List for Weed and Invasive Species Control

1. Round Up Quick Pro Herbicide®

- o A broad-spectrum herbicide used for spot treatment of weeds in municipal infrastructure areas such as sidewalks, curbs, and fence lines.

- o EPA Registration Number is indicated by the first two letters on the batch (SE) 73427-IN-001, (GR) 228-MS-001, (CH) 2228-IL-001, (H) 070989-IA-001
 - o A broad-spectrum herbicide used for spot treatment of weeds in municipal infrastructure areas such as sidewalks, curbs, and fence lines.
 - o 30.56% Dimethylamine salt of 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic acid
 - o 8.17% Dimethylamine salt of (+)-R-2-(2-Methyl-4-Chlorophenoxy) propionic acid
 - o 2.77% Dimethylamine salt of Dicamba (3,6-Dichloro-o-anisic acid)
 - o 58.50% Other ingredients
 - o Labeled Application Rate: per manufacturer's label- Apply at a rate of 1.5 oz with a gallon of water per 1,000 sq. ft.
3. Terro Carpenter Ant & Termite Killer®
- o EPA Registration Number 1021-2754-149
 - o A broad-spectrum insecticide highly effective against Ants, Bees, Carpenter Ants, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Fleas, Flour Beetles, Grain Beetles, Ground Beetles, Millipedes, Mole Crickets, Moths, Pillbugs, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Stink Bugs, Termites, Ticks, and many other similar crawling insects.
 - o 0.3% Deltamethrin
 - o 99.97% Other ingredients
 - o Labeled Application Rate: per manufacturer's label- Spot spread
4. BioAdvanced Insect Disease & Mite Control®
- o EPA Registration Number 92564-63
 - o A broad-spectrum insecticide effective against Adelgids, Aphids, Leaf Feeding Caterpillars, Japanese Beetles (adult), Lace Bugs, Leaf-Feeding Beetles, Leafhoppers (including Glassy-Winged Sharpshooter), Leafminers, Mealybugs, Psyllids, Spider Mites, Thrips, Whiteflies, and others as well as Anthracnose, Black Spot, Leaf Spot, Petal Blight, Powdery Mildew, Rust, Scab, & other diseases.
 - o 0.61% Tau-fluvalinate
 - o 0.65% Tebuconazole
 - o 98.74% Other ingredients
 - o Labeled Application Rate: per manufacturer's label- Apply to a targeted area
5. Spectracide Wasp & Hornet Killer®
- o EPA Registration Number 9688-190-8845
 - o An insecticide designed to kill Wasps, Hornets, and Yellow Jackets, and eliminate nests where they live and breed. The product also kills Mud Daubers, Tent Caterpillars, and Scorpions.
 - o 0.025% Prallethrin
 - o 0.010% Lambda cyhalothrin

- o 99.965% Other ingredients ** Contains petroleum distillates
- o Labeled Application Rate: per manufacturer's label- Apply to a targeted area

Public Safety

These EPA-registered pesticides, herbicides, and insecticides can be safely applied in residential areas. Special use instructions and restrictions for each type and event may be posted at the time of application.
