"**Sudden cardiac arrest** occurs without warning or within minutes after symptoms appear. More than 350,000 cardiac arrests occur outside of the hospital each year. The location of the out of hospital cardiac arrest (OHCA) most often occurs in homes or residences, (73.4%) followed by public settings (16.3%), and nursing homes (10.3%). If performed immediately, CPR can **double or triple** the chance of survival from an OHCA. The 2023 Heart Disease and Stroke Statistics state that among the over 356,000 OHCA that occurred, 40.2% receive bystander CPR (American Heart Association).

### HEALTHCARE PROVIDER (BLS)

This course teaches CPR skills for victims of all ages (including ventilation with a protective barrier device, the use of an AED, the use of a bag valve mask, and foreign body airway obstruction.) This class is designed for healthcare professionals, EMT students, nursing school students, childcare and daycare facility employees and DCFS participants, but anyone can sign-up for the class. This class meets the requirements set by the American Heart Association, and is required to maintain most professional medical licenses.

### Heartsaver®/AED

The Heartsaver/AED course is designed to teach CPR, the use of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED), and what to do in the event of a choking emergency for victims of all ages. This class is highly recommended for new parents, babysitters and anyone that wishes to help in the event of an emergency.

### CPR IN SPANISH

In an effort to make CPR training available for everyone, the Hanover Park Fire Department is able to teach Heartsaver/AED group classes in Spanish. All materials are also available in Spanish. Contact FF/PM Rosa Gonzalez for more information. (630) 823-5800

### Heartsaver®/ First Aid

The Heartsaver First Aid course teaches participants first aid basics for the most common first aid emergencies, including how to recognize them, how to call for help, and how to perform lifesaving skills. This class is designed for anyone with little or no medical training who needs first aid training to meet job, regulatory or licensing requirements.

### Stop The Bleed

A life-threatening bleeding injury can happen anywhere, and the person next to a victim may very well be the one most likely to prevent fatal bleeding. Participants in the American College of Surgeon's (ACS) Stop the Bleed course will learn how to recognize life-threatening bleeding and act quickly to control it with three quick techniques. This course will empower participants to make a life-or-death difference when an emergency happens.
