

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the County of DuPage, through the Stormwater Management division and municipalities, townships and park districts, recognizes ongoing stream cleaning and restoration as essential for the preservation of waterways throughout DuPage County and northeastern Illinois; and

WHEREAS, DuPage County River Sweep is a county-wide stream cleanup and restoration event organized by The Conservation Foundation and held in cooperation with American Rivers National River Clean Up; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the River Sweep is to encourage citizens and volunteer groups to help "sweep our rivers clean" by picking up debris in and along our waterways, and by participating in stream restoration projects; and

WHEREAS, stream cleaning efforts have been highly successful with more than 9,500 volunteers removing nearly 230 tons of debris from DuPage County streams since 1991; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanover Park congratulate The Conservation Foundation on 23 successful years for this event; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that all residents of the Village of Hanover Park, DuPage County, Illinois are encouraged to make a difference in the quality of water in Hanover Park, and are further urged to support and participate in "River Sweep 2014" on Saturday, May 17, 2014.
