Whereas, in 1964, the Hanover Park Park District was formed and established as a general Park District by the voters of Hanover Park, acquiring Ahlstrand Park from Barney Dahl; and

Whereas, in 1965, the Village donated Jensen Park and deeded Edgebrook Park; and

Whereas, in 1975, the Hanover Park Park District became members of the Northwest Special Recreation Association, made up of several area park districts, to manage special recreation needs for our residents; and

Whereas, in 1976, the Park District was named a "National Gold Medal Award" finalist as one of the top five parks and recreation agencies of its size in the nation; and

Whereas, in 1982, the Hanover Park Park Foundation was formed to accept land donations; and

Whereas, in 1994, the Park District and the community celebrate the Community Center renovation and expansion with an Open House; and


Whereas, in 2008, the Hanover Park Park Foundation held its 1st annual Youth Benefit Ball at the Seville Lions and HP-CRC.
