WHEREAS, Bob Wachsmuth has been a resident of Hanover Park for over 23 years, where he and his wife Virginia have lived in the same location until they decided to relocate to be closer to family; and

WHEREAS, Bob Wachsmuth was appointed as a member on the Environmental Committee on October 4, 2007, and has served as Chair on the Committee; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure on the Environmental Committee, Bob Wachsmuth was involved with the development of the first Public Apiary in Illinois, as well as Hanover Park's annual Recycling Event, where he was responsible for the diversion of 128 tons of material from landfills, and 2,923 gallons of oil being recycled; and

WHEREAS, Bob Wachsmuth has served as a member of the Citizens Corp Council, as well as the Fire Corps and was involved in securing funds for the Fire Corps, as well as the CERT rehab vehicle; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, Bob Wachsmuth was awarded with the Chief's Commendation Ribbon by Chief Haigh for obtaining the CHMMunity Grant of \$1,000 from the National CHMM to be used for Fire Corp Operations; and

WHEREAS, Bob Wachsmuth was Citizen of the Year in 2010 for his role in heading up the Village's first Household Recycling Event, and for arranging a tour of the recycling center where the Village's household recycling is sorted and a tour of the electric recycling facility.
