## **INTRODUCTION**

Sudden cardiac arrest is a leading cause of death. Nearly 360,000 “out of hospital” cardiac arrests occur annually in the United States, and survival depends on immediately receiving CPR and the use of an AED. A recent study shows that nearly 89% of all “out of hospital” cardiac arrests do not receive immediate care from bystanders on the scene. The Hanover Park Fire Department, in association with the American Heart Association, is dedicated to teaching you the life saving skills you will need in the event of a sudden cardiac arrest.

## **OUR GOAL**

- Be a model of excellence in CPR/First Aid training.

## **ON-SITE INSTRUCTION AVAILABLE**

The Hanover Park Fire Department has the ability to teach CPR in your place of business.

### **Requirements:**

1. Class size of at least 10 people.
2. The ability to play a DVD in an area that allows all participants to hear and see the video screen.

## **HEARTSAVER/AED**

The HeartSaver/AED course is designed to teach CPR, the use of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED), and what to do in the event of a choking emergency for victims of all ages. This course is designed for those that are expected to help in the event of an emergency in the workplace. This class is also highly recommended for new parents, babysitters, and anyone that wishes to help in the event of an emergency. This class follows the recommendations set by the American Heart Association.

## **HEALTHCARE PROVIDER (BLS)**

This course is designed to teach the skills of CPR to victims of all ages (including ventilation with a protective barrier device, the use of an AED, the use of a bag valve mask, and foreign-body airway obstruction). This class is intended for HealthCare professionals that work both in and out of a hospital setting, EMT students, nursing school students, childcare/daycare facility employees and DCFS participants. This class meets the requirements set by the American Heart Association, and is required to maintain most Professional Medical Licenses.

## **FIRST AID\***

This course will educate the Rescuer on three core modules with the option of a fourth.

1. General Principles of First Aid
2. Medical Emergencies
3. Injury Emergencies
4. Environmental Emergencies

These modules teach the public how to manage illnesses and injuries in the first critical minutes before professional help arrives.

## **CPR IN SPANISH\***

In an effort to make CPR training available for everyone, the Hanover Park Fire Department has begun teaching HeartSaver/AED in Spanish. Currently we have two Spanish speaking instructors that are eager to provide CPR training to our growing community. All materials are also available in Spanish.
