WHEREAS, October is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month and October 16th is National Mammography Day; and

WHEREAS, breast cancer has the second highest mortality rate in women, and is the second most diagnosed cancer; and

WHEREAS, every two minutes a woman is diagnosed with breast cancer, and 30% of new women's cancer diagnoses will be from breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, about 1 in 8 U.S. women in the United States will be diagnosed with breast cancer during her lifetime. In the United States in 2022, over 339,250 new cases of breast cancer are projected to be diagnosed in women; and


WHEREAS, men can also get breast cancer, and more than 2,700 new cases of breast cancer are expected to be diagnosed in men each year; and

WHEREAS, 98% of all breast cancer patients survive when the disease is detected early and there are over 2.9 million breast cancer survivors in the United States; and

WHEREAS, mammography, an "x-ray of the breast", can detect breast cancer up to two years before physical symptoms can be seen or felt;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Rodney S. Craig, President of the Village of Hanover Park, do hereby declare **October 2022 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month and October 16th as National Mammography Day** in the Village of Hanover Park.
